Aim of the Awards

The aim of these of awards is to recognise and encourage the performance of Cleveland Bay competition horses throughout Australasia. The CBHSA feels that it is the Cleveland Bays' presence in the performance arena that will contribute greatly to increased awareness of the breed. This could potentially create a greater demand for Cleveland Bays and ultimately save the breed from extinction.

High Point Awards Overview

The CBHSA High Point Awards are open to all financial members of the CBHSA and their registered horses. Points are awarded based on both the competitor's placing and the number of horses in the class. All classes and placings must be validated by steward, judge or event organiser on the day of the competition on the official CBHSA score card.

Score cards will be sent out with new membership, with one card included in the membership fee. On this card, horse and rider combinations must nominate one discipline to accumulate points for. This does not restrict them from competing outside their nominated discipline, as cards for extra disciplines can be purchased for a small fee. Additional cards for other horses can also be purchased for a small fee. Any discipline with less than 3 horses having points submitted in a given year shall have no award given for that discipline.

The point accumulation period runs between February 1st and January 31st the following year. Points are to be submitted twice during the year, on July 15th and February 15th. Points will not be accepted after February 15th.

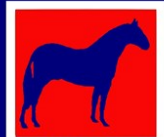

Stud Award

Points are awarded to breeders based on the performance of all Cleveland Bays bred by them and competing under their stud prefix. These horses do not need to be owned by the breeder. The stud prefix must be registered with the CBHSA.

One point will be given to each breeder for every horse competing with that breeder's prefix. The Stud Award is only open to those breeders who have paid a current Stud Registration or hold a Life Stud Membership.

Newcomer Award

Cleveland Bays are eligible for this award in their first season of competing under saddle. Horses are to be a minimum of 4 years old from the beginning of the point accumulation period (February 1st).

Encouragement Award

Awarded at the CBHSA Committee's discretion, to someone who has displayed courage, generosity, honesty, integrity and true sportsmanship throughout the year both in competition and through general contact with other members of the Society and general public.

Regional Awards

State/Territory Award

Highest points overall gained by a competitor who resides in each state/territory of Australia

New Zealand Award

Highest points overall gained by a competitor who resides in New Zealand

Dressage

An overall dressage scoring system, which covers all levels of dressage.

All percentages gained in competition tests shall be added together, including bonus points, and an award given to the highest overall score. Training tests are not included in the scoring system.

Percentages gained in tests PLUS

1 bonus point awarded for each test ridden PLUS

10 bonus points awarded for progression through grades

Show Horse

Points are awarded as per table below for breed showing and open ring hacking. The following also gain bonus points; Supreme (5 points), Champion (4 points) and Reserve (3 points). In breed showing, only placings in Led and Ridden classes are eligible.

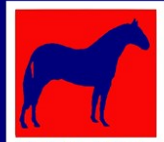

Showjumping

Grades are split into two separate categories, with the intention of encouraging the lower grades whilst also recognising the dedication required to achieve at the higher grades.

Eventing/Combined Training

1st	6 points	15 points
2nd	5 points	14 points

1 bonus point awarded for progression through grades in PC/HRC/V/Adult Riders

5 bonus points awarded for progression through grades in FEI/EA/Official
